With 2030 as the target year, international targets have been set in 17 fields, including poverty, education, energy, climate change, and industry. In order to utilize the free-thinking of young people, who are the next generation leaders to achieve the SDGs, we will recruit participants from Universities of Technology, Colleges of National Institute of Technology (KOSEN) in Japan, and overseas, to learn the basics of the SDGs, and also to collaborate via lectures, group work, on-site inspections, presentations, while aiming to develop human resources who can contribute to the realization of a super smart society and clean energy.
